## PLAN FOR YOUR UNIVERSITY FUTURE WITH AGECE

### **WHAT IS AGECE?**

- *AGECE stands for Arizona Education Curriculum*
- *AGECE is a statewide agreement between all Arizona public community colleges and the three public universities, ASU, NAU, and U of A.*
- *AGECE is a 35-semester-hour block of lower division general education courses that fulfills the lower division general education requirements at all three Arizona state public universities*
- *AGECE includes three different blocks: AGECE-A for the Associate of Arts*
- *AGECE-B, for the Associate of Business and an AGECE-S for the Associate of Science*

### **WHY COMPLETE AN AGECE?**

- *Guaranteed, unconditional admission to all three Arizona state public universities (this does not guarantee admission to some colleges or professional programs within the universities)*
- *Lower-division general education or liberal studies requirements will be met and transfer as a block to all three universities.*
- *Save money by completing these requirements at Yavapai College where tuition is significantly less than at Arizona public universities.*

### **WHY COMPLETE AN ASSOCIATES DEGREE AT YAVAPAI COLLEGE?**

- *There are three new statewide transfer degrees:*
  - **Associates of Arts**
  - **Associates of Science**
  - **Associates of Business**
- *An AGECE is a part of the above three Yavapai College associate degree*
- *Upon completion of the correct associate degree “**pathway**”, you will be assured that all credits will transfer and apply to the specified baccalaureate degree and you will be granted junior status.*

### **MEET WITH A YAVAPAI COLLEGE ACADEMIC ADVISOR TO HELP YOU:**

- *Determine which AGECE and Associate degree pathway, if any, are appropriate for your academic plans. A pathway requires completion of at least 6 credits of courses in your major. See an advisor for a detailed explanation.*
- *Be certain that your transcripts are coded correctly in order for the statewide agreements to be valid*
- *Make a decision on a possible major by the time you complete a maximum of **30** credit hours. Some majors require that a decision be made within the first **15** credit hours completed, in order to have all credits apply toward degree requirements*
